- Erica Boyd – Transportation Advisory Board Member – spoke about the objectives and board concerns around demographics and trends.

Committee comments included the following:

- The City’s highest priority is safety.
- The plan feels limited and should include information from professionals.
- The Goals and Priorities seem to be in alignment with the Mobility Plan.
- There appears to be some overlap among objectives.
- The Committee felt it needed more technical data in order to be able to better set priorities.
- This is an iterative process. The City will see what works and why. Learn and move through the goals and objectives list.
- The City’s system needs to serve its citizens best, regardless of where other jurisdictions are in developing their systems.
- Accurate, real-time, traveler information is already being provided by the internet.
- Staff should be mindful of improving ease of travel “in” town as opposed to “through” town.
- There may be some public desire for better communication regarding road construction in town, though Committee members felt that the City did a pretty good job already.
- Committee was supportive of the projects and the listed goals.
